Submission of the proposal at national/regional level (schedule, cut-off dates, deadlines, etc.)	<p>Taiwanese project partners shall submit a proposal to the NSTC for national financing after the project has been selected and approved for funding through the M-ERA.NET evaluation and selection process.</p> <p>The proposals are required to be submitted to NSTC for funding as soon as possible as the internal process of the NSTC generally takes 6 months.</p>
